	SECTION 1. Chapter 11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amende	d
2	by adding a new section to subpart H of part XIII, to be	
	appropriately designated and to read as follows:	
	" <u>§11-</u> Microtargeting of political advertisements;	
	prohibited. (a) No advertisement that is broadcast, televised	.,
	distributed online, or otherwise communicated by electronic	
	neans shall be targeted to a specific group of individuals on	
	the basis of:	
	(1) Online behavioral data;	
	(2) Demographic characteristics shared by members of the	
	group; or	
	(3) Geographic location at a level smaller than electoral	:
	district.	
	(b) The fine for violation of this section shall not	
	exceed for each advertisement, and shall not exceed	
	an aggregate amount of ."	
	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.	

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1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
