
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE GAME MANAGEMENT ADVISORY COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 183D-4.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) There is established within the department a game
4 management advisory commission, which shall serve in an advisory
5 capacity to the board. The game management advisory commission
6 shall consist of the following nine members:

7 (1) One member from the county of Kauai;

8 (2) Three members from the county of Maui, with one member
9 from each of the islands of Maui, Lanai, and Molokai;

10 (3) Two members from the county of Hawaii, with one member
11 from east Hawaii and one member from west Hawaii;

12 (4) One member from the city and county of Honolulu;

13 (5) One at-large member; and

14 (6) The chairperson of the board of land and natural
15 resources or the chairperson's designated
16 representative, who shall serve as an ex officio,
17 voting member;



1 provided that each member, other than the chairperson of the
2 board, shall be appointed by the governor from a list of nine
3 names submitted by the president of the senate and a list of
4 nine names submitted by the speaker of the house of
5 representatives in the manner provided in section 26-34, shall
6 be a hunter licensed in the State under this chapter, and shall
7 have leadership experience in working directly with local hunter
8 or shooting organizations; provided further that at least one
9 member shall have knowledge, experience, and expertise in the
10 area of native Hawaiian cultural practices; and provided further
11 that no more than three members shall represent, be employed by,
12 or be under contract to any sector of government."

13 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
