

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FORTY-SIXTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue general obligation bonds in the sum of \$25,000,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2021-2022 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the forty-sixth representative district, as follows:

3 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
4 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
5 of June 30, 2024, shall lapse as of that date.

6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
