The fiscal year 2021-2022 appropriations under 16 this Act shall not lapse until the end of fiscal biennium 2021-17 2023; provided that funds appropriated or authorized by this Act 18 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2023, shall 19 lapse as of that date.
