
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. There is appropriated or authorized from the
3 sources of funding indicated below to collective bargaining
4 statewide (BUF 102) the following sums or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary to fund for fiscal biennium 2021-2023 all
6 collective bargaining cost items in the agreement negotiated
7 with the exclusive representative of collective bargaining unit
8 (8):

7 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is
8 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds
9 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be,
10 from the respective funds.

11 SECTION 10. The fiscal year 2021-2022 appropriations under
12 this Act shall not lapse until the end of fiscal biennium 2021-
13 2023; provided that funds appropriated or authorized by this Act
14 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2023, shall
15 lapse as of that date.

16 SECTION 11. This Act shall take effect on December 25,
17 2040.
