BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. The purpose of this Act is to require:
2	(1)	The department of land and labor industrial relations
3		to disseminate information regarding seizure first
4		aid; and
5	(2)	Employers to post materials provided by the department
6		of labor and industrial relations to educate employees
7		with respect to seizure first aid.
8	SECTION 2. Chapter 396, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
9	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated	
10	and to read as follows:	
11	"§396- Seizure first aid; information. (a) The	
12	department shall provide employers, employees, and the general	
13	public wi	th information with respect to rendering seizure first
14	aid. The	information shall be disseminated through exhibitions,
15	broadcast	s, lectures, posters, flyers, pamphlets, or any other
16	method of	disseminating information.

1	(b) All employers shall post information on seizure first		
2	aid provided by the department in a prominent position in the		
3	employer's workplace.		
4	(c) The department shall adopt rules in accordance with		
5	chapter 91 to implement this section.		
6	(d) For the purposes of this section, "seizure first aid"		
7	means procedures to respond, attend, and provide comfort and		
8	safety to a person suffering from a primary generalized tonic-		
9	clonic seizure or complex partial seizure. The term does not		
10	include training to medically treat a person suffering a		
11	seizure."		
12	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.		
13	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
