SECTION 1. Section 707-700, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by amending the definition of "emergency worker" to read 2 3 as follows: 4 ""Emergency worker" means any: 5 (1)Law enforcement officer, including any police officer, 6 public safety officer, parole or probation officer, or 7 any other officer of any county, state, federal, or 8 military agency authorized to exercise law enforcement 9 or police powers; 10 (2) Firefighter, emergency medical services personnel, 11 emergency medical technician, ambulance crewmember, 12 Hawaii state on-scene coordinator, or any other 13 emergency response personnel; 14 (3) Member of the Hawaii National Guard on any duty or 15 service done under or in pursuance of an order or call 16 of the governor or the President of the United States 17 or any proper authority;
