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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 97-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

amended to read as follows:

"\$97-4 Manner of filing; public records. All statements

required by this chapter to be filed with the state ethics

commission:

(1) Shall be deemed properly filed when delivered or

- (1) Shall be deemed properly filed when delivered or deposited in an established post office within the prescribed time[7]; duly stamped, registered, or certified[7]; and directed to the state ethics commission; provided[7, however7] that in the event it is not received, a duplicate of the statement shall be promptly filed upon notice by the state ethics commission of its nonreceipt; and
- (2) Shall be <u>permanently</u> preserved by the state ethics commission [for a period of four years from the date of filing]; and shall constitute part of the public records of the state ethics commission."
