RELATING TO STATE GOVERNMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 201, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part V to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§201-</u> Definitions. As used in this part:
5	"Board" means the board of directors of the Pacific
6	international space center for exploration systems.
7	"Space center" means the Pacific international space center
8	for exploration systems."
9	SECTION 2. Chapter 201, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10	amended as follows:
11	1. By amending the title of part V to read:
12	"PART V. [OFFICE OF AEROSPACE DEVELOPMENT] PACIFIC
13	INTERNATIONAL SPACE CENTER FOR EXPLORATION SYSTEMS"
14	2. By amending the title of part V, subpart B, to read:
15	"[B. PACIFIC INTERNATIONAL SPACE CENTER FOR EXPLORATION
16	SYSTEMS]"

3	(3)	Work with local universities and community colleges to
4		facilitate internships for students with the space
5		center and associated companies;
6	(4)	Continue to work with the University of Hawaii on
7		course development, teaching, workforce development,
8		and outreach;
9	(5)	Promote innovative educational and workforce
10		development programs that will enhance public
11		awareness of the space center and enable residents to
12		pursue employment in Hawaii's aerospace industry;
13	(6)	Act as the public representative of the space center;
14	(7)	Monitor national and global trends in the aerospace
15		industry and promote global awareness of the space
16		center;
17	(8)	Pursue projects in the aerospace sector that can be
18		leveraged for improvements to the State's broadband
19		and alternative energy capabilities;
20	(9)	Serve as a clearinghouse for information on the space
21		center and associated activities;

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1	(10)	Target existing businesses that can provide products
2		or services of importance to the space center and its
3		projects to support the expansion of these businesses
4		in Hawaii;
5	(11)	Increase contact and maintain liaison with the
6		National Aeronautics and Space Administration, related
7		aerospace organizations, and other federal agencies
8		and facilities;
9	(12)	Maintain and expand liaisons with local business and
10		citizen groups;
11	[(13)	Work with private landowners in the vicinity to expand
12		opportunities and physical space and appurtenances for
13		the participants in the space center's acrospace
14		technology research and development park;
15	(14)]	(13) Adopt, amend, and repeal rules pursuant to
16		chapter 91 necessary to carry out this [subpart;]

18	[(15)]	(14) Contract for services as may be necessary for
19		the purposes of this [subpart;] <u>part;</u> and

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1	SECTION 5. Section 201-80.2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) There is established in the state treasury the
4	Pacific international space center for exploration systems
5	special fund, into which shall be deposited:
6	(1) Revenues, moneys, and fees from services, rentals,
7	publications, royalties, and patents generated under
8	this [subpart;] part;
9	(2) Gifts, donations, and grants received by the Pacific
10	international space center for exploration systems;
11	and
12	(3) Proceeds from revenue bonds issued by the director of
13	finance."
14	SECTION 6. Subpart A, part V, chapter 201, Hawaii Revised
15	Statutes, is repealed.
16	SECTION 7. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
18	SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
