Report Title: Militia; National Guard

Description:

Improves and enhances the ability to have Hawaii National Guard personnel who can serve on active duty in the service of the State without financial hardship through modifications and additions to chapter 121, Hawaii Revised Statutes by authorizing the Hawaii National Guard to add the payment of Tricare Reserve Select or other government funded premium payments to the authorized service member who are not otherwise covered by the State or federally funded medical insurance.

A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE HAWAII NATIONAL GUARD.

H.B.N. 15

PURPOSE: Authorize the Hawaii National Guard to add the payment of Tricare Reserve Select or other government funded premium payments to the authorized allowances for officers, warrant officers, and enlisted personnel while on active duty in the service of the State who are not otherwise covered by State or federally funded medical insurance.

MEANS: Amend section 121-39 & -40, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS).

JUSTIFICATION: There currently is no authority for insurance to be provided for Hawaii National Guard personnel who are called to active duty in the service of the State covered under section 121-39 or 121-40, HRS. During periods where personnel are activated for more than thirty (30) days, they will likely have no medical insurance to cover them and their families for routine medical care; only the service member is covered for injuries or illnesses determined to have occurred or caused by their performance of duty. Typically, this creates a personal and financial hardship for the service member and their family should an issue arise which requires medical treatment. This hardship makes it more difficult to provide personnel who are able to volunteer for active duty in the service of the State without great personal hardship to them, their families, and potentially to their employer, should the employer continue to provide medical insurance.

> Impact on the public: The authorization for the inclusion of Tricare Reserve Select or other government funded premium payments to be included as an allowance will assist in

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increased recruiting efforts for the Hawaii National Guard as well as create a more available force to provide immediate response to the citizens of the State of Hawaii.

Impact on the department and other agencies: Positive impact to the Department of Defense. No known negative impact to other departments.
