A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF HEALTHCARE ASSURANCE SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, in response to the
- 2 COVID-19 pandemic, there is increased need for public and health
- 3 care facility education and outreach to assure appropriate and
- 4 high-quality health care facility access.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to increase the annual
- 6 expenditure ceiling of the office of health care assurance
- 7 special fund to offset increasing operational expenses that
- 8 include contracts to implement a new management information
- 9 system and background checks system, as well as diminish
- 10 dependence on the general fund.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 321-1.4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended by amending subsections (b) and (c) to read as follows:
- "(b) Moneys in the special fund shall be expended by the
- 14 department of health:
- 15 (1) To assist in offsetting operating costs and
- 17 health's office of health care assurance; and

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1	(2) For	the purpose of enhancing the capacity of office of
2	health care assurance programs to:	
3	(A)	Improve public health outreach efforts, program
4		and community development, and consultations to
5		industries regulated;
6	(B)	Educate the public, the staff of the department
7		of health, and other departments within the
8		State, as well as staff and providers of all
9		health care facilities and agencies regulated;
10		[and] <u>;</u>
11	(C)	Administer and support the durable medical
12		equipment supplier license program established
13		pursuant to part XLIII[+]; and
14	<u>(D)</u>	Conduct investigations.
15	Not more	than [\$327,000] \$ of the special fund
16	may be used during any fiscal year for the activities carried	
17	out by the office of health care assurance.	
18	(c) Any amount in the special fund in excess of $[\$387,500]$	
19	\$ on	June 30 of each year shall be deposited into the
20	general fund."

Office of Health Care Assurance Special Fund; Ceiling

Description:

Increases ceiling of the office of health care assurance special fund to meet expanding program needs and diminish dependence on the general fund. Permits the office of health care assurance to use the special fund to enhance the office of health care assurance's capacity to conduct investigations. Effective 7/1/2060. (HD1)

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
