HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE AMENDMENT OF A TERM, NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENT COVERING A PORTION OF STATE SUBMERGED LANDS AT KAPAA, KAWAIHAU, KAUAI, FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A GROIN AND FOR SMALL-SCALE BEACH RESTORATION, AND FOR USE, REPAIR, AND MAINTENANCE OF THE IMPROVEMENTS CONSTRUCTED THEREON.

1	WHEREAS, certain property is located on a portion of
2	government land located seaward of Kapaa, Kawaihau, Kauai and
3	identified as Tax Map Key: (4) 4-3-009:seaward of 050; and
4	
5	WHEREAS, a shoreline encroachment exists on the property;
6	and
7	
8	WHEREAS, in 2012, removal of a seventy-foot long concrete
9 10	groin at the northern boundary of the site resulted in severe
10	erosion in the area; and
12	WHEREAS, the groin served to shelter the subject beach from
12	nearshore currents which in turn served to slow littoral drift;
14	and

16	WHEREAS, removal of the groin resulted in an increase of
17	longshore littoral drift, which in turn exacerbated erosion so
18	that approximately five hundred cubic yards of sand were
19	transported away from the subject beach over a two-year period;
20	and

22	WHEREAS, in response to the erosion, a temporary emergency
23	erosion control structure was installed in 2017, with
24	authorization from the Department of Land and Natural Resources,
25	and in 2020, the emergency structure was repaired and
26	lengthened; and

1 WHEREAS, the emergency structure was authorized to remain 2 in place for a period of three years while a long-term solution could be implemented; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, the small-scale beach nourishment project was 6 approved by the Department of Land and Natural Resources on June 4, 2019 (DLNR Ref: SSBN KA 19-3830); and 7 8 9 WHEREAS, as part of the small-scale beach nourishment 10 authorization, the emergency erosion control structure 11 (DLNR Ref: Emer. CDUA KA-17-16) was authorized to remain in 12 place until the second nourishment effort is initiated, 13 approximately three years following the initial nourishment; and 14 15 WHEREAS, the proposed long-term solution was developed by a 16 consultant to the Association of Unit Owners of Kauai Kailani Condominiums, which subsequently applied for approval of the 17 installation of a temporary sandbag groin structure and 18 19 placement of approximately 1,140 cubic yards of beach-quality 20 sand sourced from the Waipouli Drainage Canal at Tax Map 21 Key: (4) 4-3-008:017; and 22 23 WHEREAS, the sand intended to be used for the fill is 24 compatible with the existing beach following the Guidelines for 25 SSBN Cat II General Application of the Office of Conservation and Coastal Lands of the Department of Land and Natural 26 27 Resources; and 28 WHEREAS, beach nourishment is proposed to take place over 29 30 one preliminary nourishment, followed by several smaller 31 periodic nourishments to ensue over a ten-year period; and 32 33 WHEREAS, the Office of Conservation and Coastal Lands of the Department of Land and Natural Resources recommended that 34 the Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources 35 approve the Category II Small Scale Beach Nourishment 36 application KA-19-3830 for the Kauai Kailani Groin and Sand 37 Placement Project at Kapaa, Kauai, fronting Tax Map 38 39 Keys: (4) 4-3-009:-50 and (4) 4-3-008:017; and 40 WHEREAS, as a result, the evaluation criteria of the Office 41 42 of Conservation and Coastal Lands of the Department of Land and

1 Natural Resources supported a disposition of shoreline 2 encroachment by the issuance of an easement; and 3 4 WHEREAS, on February 14, 2020, under agenda item D-3, the Board of Land and Natural Resources approved the issuance of a 5 right-of-entry permit for the construction, maintenance, and 6 repair of a temporary emergency erosion control structure to the 7 8 Association of Unit Owners of Kauai Kailani; and 9 10 WHEREAS, the subject area is about 1,764 square feet, which will be reviewed and approved by the Department of Accounting 11 and General Services' Land Survey Division; and 12 13 14 WHEREAS, the grantee will be required to pay the State the 15 fair market value of the easement as consideration for the use of public lands to be determined by an independent appraiser; 16 17 and 18 19 WHEREAS, section 171-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires the prior approval of the Governor and prior authorization of 20 21 the Legislature by concurrent resolution to lease state submerged lands; now, therefore, 22 23 24 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 25 Thirty-first Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2021, the Senate concurring, that the Board of Land and 26 Natural Resources is hereby authorized to amend a term, non-27 exclusive easement covering a portion of state submerged lands 28 located seaward of Kapaa, Kawaihau, Kauai, and identified as Tax 29 Map Key: (4) 4-3-009:seaward of 050 for construction of a groin 30 and for use, repair, and maintenance of the existing 31 improvements constructed thereon pursuant to section 171-53, 32 Hawaii Revised Statutes; and 33 34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 35 36 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and 37 Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources. 38 39 OFFERED BY: Madnie K.
