HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION TO ADOPT RULES PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 91, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES, TO REQUIRE VEHICLE INSPECTIONS TO ASSESS THE LEVEL OF NOISE EMITTED BY THE VEHICLE'S EXHAUST.

1 WHEREAS, exposure to prolonged or high-volume noise has been shown to cause a range of health problems, including 2 hearing loss, stress, hypertension, high blood pressure, high 3 4 cholesterol, speech interference, and sleep disruption; and 5 6 WHEREAS, motor vehicles are a major source of noise in the 7 community; and 8 9 WHEREAS, existing state law prohibits the sale, alteration, 10 and any installation of a muffler that noticeably increases the noise emitted by a motor vehicle above that emitted by the 11 vehicle as equipped from the factory; and 12 13 14 WHEREAS, however, the existing law is difficult to enforce 15 because it requires a comparison to the vehicle as distributed from the factory; and 16 17 WHEREAS, noise restrictions will be easier to enforce if 18 the specific noise level is specified and may be assessed in a 19 formal process, such as through motor vehicle safety 20 inspections; now, therefore, 21 22 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 23 Thirty-first Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 24 of 2021, the Senate concurring, that the Director of 25 Transportation is requested to adopt rules pursuant to 26 27 chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to require vehicle inspections to assess the level of noise emitted by the 28 29 vehicle's exhaust; and

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is requested that the 1 standard for maximum allowed noise level be set at 94 decibels 2 3 for all motor vehicles; and 4 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 6 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of 7 Transportation. 8 9 10 OFFERED BY:
