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## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

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REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ESTABLISH A TASK  
FORCE TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE PROPER IDENTIFICATION  
AND DISPOSAL OF ABANDONED AND DERELICT VEHICLES LEFT ON THE  
STATE'S HIGHWAYS AND CITY AND COUNTY ROADWAYS.

1 WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that of the 1,267,136  
2 vehicles registered in the State in 2018, sixty-three per cent  
3 were registered in the City and County of Honolulu; and  
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5 WHEREAS, the traffic congestion in Honolulu consistently  
6 ranks among the worst in the nation; and  
7

8 WHEREAS, in 2018, more than three thousand abandoned and  
9 derelict cars were removed from Honolulu's city streets, an  
10 increase of over fifty per cent from 2017; and  
11

12 WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes that the presence of  
13 abandoned and derelict cars worsens existing traffic congestion;  
14 now, therefore,  
15

16 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
17 Thirty-first Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
18 of 2021, the Senate concurring, that the Department of  
19 Transportation is requested to establish a task force to make  
20 recommendations on the proper identification and disposal of  
21 abandoned and derelict vehicles left on the State's highways and  
22 city and county roadways; and  
23

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force:  
25

- 26 (1) Consider a comparison of the statutory definitions of  
27 "abandoned vehicle" and "derelict vehicle";

- (2) Consider the methods for determining or identifying whether a vehicle that is left on a state highway or city or county road is abandoned or derelict;
- (3) Consider methods to improve the determination and distinction between a derelict or abandoned vehicle to improve the process for removing, recycling, or disposing of vehicles; and
- (4) Submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2022; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall consist of:

- (1) The Director of Transportation, or the Director's designee, who shall serve as the chair of the task force;
- (2) The mayor of each county or the respective mayor's designee;
- (3) A representative from each of the county police departments;
- (4) A member of the Senate appointed by the Senate President;
- (5) A member of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and
- (6) A representative from the automobile towing industry as identified and invited by the other members of the task force; and


