

HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO INCREASE ACCESS TO ARTS AND CULTURAL INSTRUCTION IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

WHEREAS, providing a well-rounded education to all public 1 school students advances the economic and social health of 2 3 Hawaii; and 4 5 WHEREAS, art, music, and cultural curricula constitute important parts of a well-rounded education that address the 6 7 developmental needs of the whole child; and 8 9 WHEREAS, in 2013, researchers in the Department of 10 Education Reform at the University of Arkansas found that instruction in visual arts led to gains in critical-thinking 11 skills; and 12 13 WHEREAS, according to a 2014 study performed by Lois 14 Hetland and Ellen Winner of the Harvard Graduate School of 15 Education, education in music and drama shows a generalizable 16 17 causal relationship to increases in verbal achievement and 18 spatial reasoning; and 19 20 WHEREAS, Paul T. Sowden, a professor of psychology at the University of Winchester in England, has noted that arts and 21 cultural education develop children's capacity for 22 23 collaboration, creativity, and intellectual inquiry; and 24 25 WHEREAS, research performed by Mariale Hardiman, Director 26 of the Neuro-education Initiative at the Johns Hopkins School of Education, has shown that students with access to arts and 27 28 cultural content are more adept at retaining instruction regardless of subject matter, demonstrating that arts and 29 30 cultural instruction could help to mitigate learning loss; and 31 32 WHEREAS, a study conducted by researchers at the University of Missouri and the University of Texas A&M found that a 33

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substantial increase in access to arts education led to a 3.6 percentage point reduction in disciplinary infractions, an improvement of thirteen percent on standardized writing scores, and an increase of eight percent in measures of compassion for others; and

7 WHEREAS, in an article published by the Brookings 8 Institution, the same researchers concluded that the arts 9 "challenge us with different points of view, compel us to 10 empathize with others, and give us the opportunity to reflect on 11 the human condition"; and

13 WHEREAS, the researchers further found that "[a]mong 14 adults, arts participation is related to behaviors that 15 contribute to the health of civil society, such as increased 16 civic engagement, greater social tolerance, and reductions in 17 other-regarding behavior"; now, therefore,

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 20 Thirty-first Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 21 of 2021, that the Department of Education is urged to increase 22 access to arts and cultural instruction in public schools; and 23

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this

Education and Superintendent of Education.
