- 5 SECTION 4. Notwithstanding the sums hereinabove stated as
- 6 interest upon judgments against the State, payment of interest
- 7 shall be limited to the period from the date of judgment, if
- 8 applicable, to thirty days after the effective date of this Act,
- 9 as provided in section 662-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for those
- 10 cases to which the statute applies.
- 11 SECTION 5. All unexpended and unencumbered balances of the
- 12 appropriations made in this Act as of the close of business on
- 13 June 30, 2022, shall lapse.
- 14 SECTION 6. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 15 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
- 16 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 17 applications of the Act, which can be given effect without the
- 18 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 19 of this Act are severable.
- 20 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
