A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DISPOSITON OF TAXES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The economic impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on
- 2 the revenues of the State has been devastating, with an
- 3 estimated decline of \$2.3 billion for fiscal biennium 2019-2021,
- 4 and necessitates action to preserve the solvency of the state
- 5 general fund and ensure the continuation of critical government
- 6 operations.
- 7 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to temporarily
- 8 suspend the requirement for disposition of the conveyance tax to
- 9 the land conservation fund and the rental housing revolving fund
- 10 for fiscal year 2021-2022 and fiscal year 2022-2023.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 247-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 "§247-7 Disposition of taxes. All taxes collected under
- 14 this chapter shall be paid into the state treasury to the credit
- 15 of the general fund of the State, to be used and expended for
- 16 the purposes for which the general fund was created and exists
- 17 by law[; provided that of the taxes collected each fiscal year:



1	(1) Ten per cent or \$5,100,000, whichever is	-less, shall

4	(2) Fifty per cent or \$38,000,000, whichever	`is less,

9	SECTION 4. This Act, upon its approval, shall	.l take effect
10	on July 1, 2050, and shall be repealed on June 30,	2023;
11	provided that section 247-7, Hawaii Revised Statut	es, shall be
12	reenacted in the form in which it read on the day	prior to the
13	effective date of this Act.
