## A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING EMERGENCY APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE RELATING TO COVID-19 EXPENDITURES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
- 2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
- 4 SECTION 2. The legislature finds that the impact of the
- 5 SARS-CoV-2 virus and resulting coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-
- 6 19) has been devastating to global, national, and state
- 7 economies. The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security
- 8 Act (CARES Act), Public Law 116-136, was enacted on March 27,
- 9 2020, to address the extensive health and economic fallout of
- 10 the COVID-19 pandemic and provided federal funds to support the
- 11 State's COVID-19 relief efforts. With the expiration of federal
- 12 CARES Act funds, the legislature finds that additional funds are
- 13 needed to continue funding critical COVID-19 response programs
- 14 and activities for the remainder of fiscal year 2020-2021.
- Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- 16 funds for the purpose of COVID-19 response activities and

- 1 provide transparency and accountability for the use of those
- 2 funds.
- 3 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$8,413,549 or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for the
- 6 transfer of contracts from the department of transportation to
- 7 the department of defense related to the safe travels Hawaii
- 8 airport screening program.
- 9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 10 defense for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$600,000 or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for use of
- 14 the Hawaii tourism authority's Hawaii convention center to
- 15 operate a call center for the safe travels Hawaii airport
- 16 screening program.
- 17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 18 defense for the purposes of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general
- 20 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$4,588,802 or so much
- 21 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for the

- 1 procurement, storage, and distribution of personal protective
- 2 equipment to schools and other state agencies for statewide
- 3 operations as may be needed.
- 4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 5 defense for the purposes of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 6. The governor is authorized to transfer funds
- 7 appropriated by this Act among all executive agencies as may be
- 8 deemed necessary and is authorized to transfer funds in excess
- 9 of what is needed for the department of defense to the
- 10 governor's contingency fund as deemed necessary by the governor
- 11 for the purposes of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 13 provided that all funds appropriated pursuant to this Act that
- 14 are unallotted or unencumbered shall lapse as of June 30, 2022.
