A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR RELATING TO COVID-19 EXPENDITURES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
- 2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
- 4 SECTION 2. The impact of the SARS-CoV-2 virus and
- 5 resulting coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) has been
- 6 devastating to global, national, and state economies.
- 7 The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act
- 8 (CARES Act), Public Law 116-136, was enacted on March 27, 2020,
- 9 to address the extensive health and economic fallout of the
- 10 COVID-19 pandemic and provided federal funds to support the
- 11 State's COVID-19 relief efforts. With the expiration of federal
- 12 CARES Act funds, the State finds that additional funds are
- 13 needed to continue funding critical COVID-19 response programs
- 14 and activities for the remainder of fiscal year 2020-2021.
- 15 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- 16 funds for the purpose of COVID-19 response activities and

- 1 provide transparency and accountability for the use of those
- 2 funds.
- 3 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 to be
- 6 used as a contingency fund by the office of the governor to
- 7 supplement the continuation of COVID-19 response related
- 8 programs and activities.
- 9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of the
- 10 governor for the purposes of this Act; provided that the
- 11 governor is authorized to transfer funds appropriated by this
- 12 Act among all executive agencies as may be deemed necessary; and
- 13 provided further that the governor is authorized to transfer
- 14 funds in excess of what is needed for each expending agency from
- 15 other emergency appropriation acts relating to COVID-19
- 16 expenditures for fiscal year 2020-2021 to the contingency fund
- 17 as deemed necessary by the governor for the purposes of this
- 18 Act.
- 19 SECTION 4. Any provision of this Act to the contrary
- 20 notwithstanding, the appropriations authorized under this Act
- 21 shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year for which the

- 1 appropriation is made. Any unexpended and unencumbered balance
- 2 of the appropriation made in this Act as of the close of
- 3 business on June 30, 2022, shall lapse.
- 4 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
