BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 263-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§263-9 Dangerous flying a misdemeanor; penalty. Any
- 4 aeronaut or passenger who, while in flight over a thickly
- 5 inhabited area or over a public gathering within the State,
- 6 engages in trick or acrobatic flying, or in any acrobatic feat,
- 7 or engages in or facilitates flying without a valid pilot
- 8 <u>license</u>, or flies, except while in landing or taking off, at
- ${f 9}$ such a low level as to endanger the persons on the surface
- 10 beneath, or drops any object except loose water or loose sand
- 11 ballast, or paper handbills, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor
- 12 and punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or
- 13 imprisonment for not more than one year, or both."
- 14 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
