# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF HEALTHCARE ASSURANCE SPECIAL FUND.

## **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

SECT	ION 1. The purpose of this Act is to:
(1)	Establish the annual expenditure ceiling of the office
	of healthcare assurance special fund through the state
	budget process, to offset increasing operational
	expenses that include contracts to implement a new
	management information system and background checks
	system, as well as diminish dependence on the general
	fund; and
(2)	Authorize the director of health to approve emergency
	spending beyond the established budget ceiling.
SECT	ION 2. Section 321-1.4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended b	y amending subsections (b) and (c) to read as follows:
"(b)	Moneys in the special fund shall be expended by the
departmen	t of health:
(1)	To assist in offsetting operating costs and
	educational program expenses of the department of
	health's office of health care assurance; and
