A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
- 2 immediate passage in accordance with article VII, section 9, of
- 3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
- 4 SECTION 2. The legislature finds that vaccination is the
- 5 primary intervention viewed as having the ability to
- 6 dramatically decrease the health impacts of the coronavirus
- 7 disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic. The overall impact of a
- 8 vaccination program during a pandemic depends on how rapidly a
- 9 viable vaccine becomes available, its effectiveness in
- 10 preventing further disease spread, its supply, and the ability
- 11 to allocate and administer it effectively and efficiently.
- In late 2020, the United States Food and Drug
- 13 Administration issued emergency use authorization of vaccines
- 14 for the prevention of COVID-19. Significant logistical support
- 15 is required for the department of health to manage the rapid
- 16 distribution and dispensing of COVID-19 vaccines. However, the

- 1 base budget of the department of health is unable to accommodate
- 2 a full-scale deployment of the vaccination plan.
- 3 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to make an emergency
- 4 appropriation for fiscal year 2020-2021 to provide funds for the
- 5 department of health to implement the State's COVID-19
- 6 vaccination plan.
- 7 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
- 10 implementation of the State of Hawaii COVID-19 vaccination plan.
- 11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 12 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 15 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
- 16 the continuation of contracted disease investigation, contact
- 17 tracing, and first contact callers for COVID-19 positive cases
- 18 and close contacts.
- 19 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 20 health for the purposes of this Act.

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- 1 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
- 4 additional supplies for front-line public health workers.
- 5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 6 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 6. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
- 10 additional testing, personal protective equipment, and
- 11 industrial hygiene services for Kalaupapa residents traveling to
- 12 Oahu for medical care.
- 13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 14 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 7. There is appropriated out of the general
- 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 17 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
- 18 overtime pay for public health nurses for COVID-19 surge
- 19 response efforts.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 21 health for the purposes of this Act.

- 1 SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
- 4 the Hawaii district health office to rent a temporary space for
- 5 contracted workers.
- 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 7 health for the purposes of this Act.
- **8** SECTION 9. There is appropriated out of the general
- 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 to
- 11 contract out first contact calling services for contact tracing
- 12 support.
- 13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 14 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 10. There is appropriated out of the general
- 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 17 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
- 18 tests contracted with Diagnostic Labs and Clinical Labs,
- 19 including the Department of Public Safety inmate testing, and
- 20 for the implementation of pediatric-oriented testing strategy.

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- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 2 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 11. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
- 6 tuberculosis clearance requirements for health care volunteers
- 7 in vaccination operations.
- 8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 9 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 12. Should any project or program paid for by
- 11 state funds under this Act later become eligible for federal
- 12 reimbursement, the federal reimbursement funds shall be
- 13 deposited into the general fund.
- 14 SECTION 13. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Report Title:

Emergency Appropriations; DOH; COVID-19 Expenses; Vaccination Plan

Description:

Makes emergency appropriations to the department of health provide funds for supplies, personnel, equipment, and related efforts to implement the State's COVID-19 vaccination plan and other COVID-19 related expenses. Requires that should any project or program paid for by state funds become eligible for federal reimbursement, those federal funds shall be deposited into the general fund. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD1)

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
