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A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OCEAN STEWARDSHIP.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii's ocean waters and the marine resources contained within are some of the 2 State's most ecologically, economically, and culturally valuable 3 environmental assets. The increasing popularity of marine 4 5 ecotourism in Hawaii requires greater measures to ensure the continued health of the State's marine ecosystems. The broad 6 7 range of recently documented anthropogenic impacts on coral reef 8 health, including coral bleaching, vessel groundings, anchoring and mooring, diving activities, poaching, land-based and water-9 10 based pollutant discharges, and other direct and indirect uses of the State's coral reefs, indicate that the department of land 11 12 and natural resources may need a more consistent and reliable source of funding to manage, protect, and restore marine 13 resources throughout the State. A sustainable funding source is 14 15 especially critical for successful implementation of the State's 16 30x30 marine management process, which aims to create a cohesive



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network of nearshore marine managed areas that benefits
 fisheries and ecosystem resilience.

The purpose of this Act is to establish the ocean stewardship special fund for the collection and use of moneys for the conservation, restoration, and enhancement of the State's marine resources, and to authorize the department of land and natural resources to collect non-resident fees for the use and enjoyment of the State's ocean resources.

9 SECTION 2. Chapter 187A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and
11 to read as follows:

"PART . OCEAN STEWARDSHIP

13 §187A- Ocean stewardship special fund. (a) There is
14 hereby established in the treasury of the State a special fund
15 known as the ocean stewardship special fund, which shall be
16 administered by the department of land and natural resources.
17 (b) The following shall be deposited into the ocean

19 (1) Moneys collected as non-resident user fees pursuant to
20 section 187A- ;

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1	(2)	Revenues due to the State derived from leases of any
2		lands, facilities, equipment, and other property owned
3		by the department of land and natural resources and
4		used for or dedicated to the management, research,
5		restoration, and enhancement of aquatic resources;
6	(3)	Moneys collected as fines, bail forfeitures,
7		attorney's fees, and administrative costs for
8		violations of subtitle 5 of title 12 or any rule
9		adopted thereunder, other than:
10		(A) Informers' fees authorized under section 187A-14;
11		(B) Fines or bail forfeitures for sport fishing
12		violations of this chapter and chapters 188, 189,
13		and 190, as authorized under section 187A-
14		9.5(b)(3); and
15		(C) Fines, bail forfeitures, or administrative fines
16		for violations of chapter 189, as authorized
17		under section 189-2.4(b)(3);
18	(4)	Moneys collected for the purposes of compensatory
19		mitigation from federal or state permitted impacts to
20		the marine environment;

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1	(5)	Grants, awards, donations, gifts, transfers, or moneys
2		derived from private or public services for the
3		purposes of subtitle 5 of title 12, other than:
4		(A) Monetary contributions or moneys collected from
5		the sale of non-monetary gifts to benefit sport
6		fish or sport fishing, as authorized under
7		section 187A-9.5(b)(5); and
8		(B) Monetary contributions or moneys collected from
9		the sale of non-monetary gifts to benefit aquatic
10		life used for commercial purposes or fishing for
11		commercial purposes, as authorized under section
12		189-2.4(b)(5); and
13	(6)	Moneys derived from interest, dividend, or other
14		income from the above sources.
15	(c)	Subject to subsection (d), the ocean stewardship
16	special f	und shall be used to:
17	(1)	Develop and carry out marine resource conservation,
18		restoration, enhancement, research, regulatory
19		measures, enforcement actions, educational activities,
20		or any other management measure intended to conserve,

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1		restore, and enhance marine resources under the	
2		jurisdiction of the State;	
3	(2)	Develop and carry out restoration and compensatory	
4		mitigation measures for impacts to the marine	
5		environment, including impacts to the marine	
6		environment from federal or state permitted actions,	
7		or violations of subtitle 5 of title 12 or any rule	
8		adopted thereunder; and	
9	(3)	Install, maintain, and replace day use mooring buoys	
10		and other infrastructure to reduce impacts to the	
11		marine ecosystem.	
12	(d)	The fund shall be held separate and apart from all	
13	other mon	eys, funds, and accounts in the department of land and	
14	natural r	esources, provided that any moneys received from the	
15	federal government, through federal programs, or from private		
16	contributions, shall be deposited and accounted for in		
17	accordance with conditions established by the agency or private		
18	entity from whom the moneys are received, and provided further		
19	that twenty per cent of all funds collected under subsection		
20	(b)(1) and (2) be payable to the office of Hawaiian affairs as		
21	ceded lands revenues. Any balance remaining in the fund at the		

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end of any fiscal year shall be carried forward in the fund for
 the next fiscal year.

3 (e) The proceeds of the ocean stewardship special fund
4 shall not be used as security for, or pledged to the payment of
5 principal or interest on, any bonds or instruments of
6 indebtedness.

7 (f) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit 8 the use of general funds or the funds of other programs and 9 activities to implement or enforce title 12, subtitle 5, or any 10 rule adopted thereunder, concerning management and conservation 11 of the State's ocean waters and the resources therein.

12 §187A- Ocean stewardship fees. The department of land 13 and natural resources may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 to 14 establish non-resident user fees for the use and enjoyment of 15 the State's ocean resources. Fees collected under this section 16 or any rule adopted thereunder shall be deposited in the ocean 17 stewardship special fund."

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SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
