A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING EMERGENCY APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY RELATING TO COVID-19 EXPENDITURES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
- 2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 3 the constitution of the State of Hawaii.
- 4 SECTION 2. The impact of the SARS-CoV-2 virus and
- 5 resulting coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic has been
- 6 devastating to global, national, and state economies.
- 7 The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act
- 8 (CARES Act), Public Law 116-136, was enacted on March 27, 2020,
- 9 to address the extensive health and economic fallout of the
- 10 COVID-19 pandemic and provided federal funds to support the
- 11 State's COVID-19 relief efforts. With the expiration of federal
- 12 CARES Act funds, the State finds that additional funds are
- 13 needed to continue funding critical COVID-19 response programs
- 14 and activities for the remainder of fiscal year 2020-2021.
- 15 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- funds for the purpose of COVID-19 response activities and 16



- 1 provide transparency and accountability for the use of those
- 2 funds.
- 3 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$2,106,460 or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
- 6 healthcare professional costs and inmate hospitalization
- 7 expenses at non-state facilities for Hawaii inmates.
- 8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 9 public safety for the purposes of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,100,000 or so much
- 12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
- 13 providing food services; and deep cleaning, disinfecting, and
- 14 sanitizing departmental offices and correctional facilities.
- 15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 16 public safety for the purposes of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general
- 18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$136,201 or so much
- 19 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
- 20 security costs, overtime, and other payroll costs for ten
- 21 existing full-time equivalent (10.00 FTE) deputy sheriff

- 1 positions to continue security screening and protocols for the
- 2 safe travels Hawaii program.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 4 public safety for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 6. The governor is authorized to transfer funds
- 6 appropriated by this Act among all executive agencies as may be
- 7 deemed necessary; provided that the governor is authorized to
- 8 transfer funds in excess of what is needed for the department of
- 9 public safety to the governor's contingency fund as deemed
- 10 necessary by the governor for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 7. The appropriations made by this Act shall not
- 12 lapse at the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations
- 13 are made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
- 14 unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.
- 15 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
