A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR CARRIER VEHICLE SAFETY INSPECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. There is a need to upgrade the methods and
- 2 procedures of state motor vehicle safety inspections because the
- 3 current system is inefficient in that legislation needs to be
- 4 passed every time an inspection fee is amended.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to provide the director of
- 6 transportation greater authority over the motor carrier vehicle
- 7 safety inspection program so that the cost to a vehicle owner
- 8 for an inspection, fees collected from inspection stations, and
- 9 administration of the program can be changed by amending
- 10 administrative rules pursuant to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised
- 11 Statutes.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 286-209, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended by amending subsections (b), (c), and (d) to read as
- 14 follows:
- "(b) The director shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91
- 16 for the administration and enforcement of motor carrier vehicle
- 17 safety inspections, including the maximum inspection fee charged

- 1 to vehicle owners, fees collected from the stations, the
- 2 issuance of certificates of safety inspection, the affixing of
- 3 motor carrier vehicle safety inspection [decals,] stickers, and
- 4 the acceptance of certificates of safety inspection issued in
- 5 other jurisdictions.
- 6 (c) The director shall initially collect a fee of \$1.50
- 7 for each motor carrier vehicle safety inspection [decal] sticker
- 8 issued by motor carrier vehicle inspection stations [-], then
- 9 collect the maximum inspection fee when the fee is established
- 10 by administrative rules pursuant to subsection (b). All moneys
- 11 [collected] received by the department of transportation
- 12 pursuant to this section shall be [paid] deposited into the
- 13 state highway fund.
- 14 (d) A fee of no more than \$12 shall initially be charged
- 15 by a motor carrier inspection station for each safety inspection
- 16 performed [-], then no more than the maximum inspection fee shall
- 17 be charged when the fee is established by administrative rules
- 18 pursuant to subsection (b)."
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 286-210, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:

- 1 "§286-210 Operation of a motor carrier vehicle without a
- 2 safety inspection [decal.] sticker. Whoever operates, permits
- 3 the operation of, causes to be operated, or parks any motor
- 4 carrier vehicle on a public highway without a current motor
- 5 carrier vehicle safety inspection [decal,] sticker, issued under
- 6 section 286-209, shall be fined \$100 for each day of the
- 7 violation."
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 9 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 10 begun, before its effective date.
- 11 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
