A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 202-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"[+](b)[+] Except for the ex officio members or their
4	designees, the council members shall be appointed by the
5	governor for four-year staggered terms as provided for in
6	section 26-34. The governor shall appoint the chairperson of
7	the council. The council shall be constituted as provided by
8	P.L. 113-128 (29 U.S.C. 3111) of the following members:
9	(1) The directors of labor and industrial relations[$_{ au}$
10	human services, and business, economic development,
11	and tourism; the superintendent of education; and the
12	president of the University of Hawaii or their
13	designees, as ex officio, voting members;
14	(2) The administrator of the division of vocational
15	rehabilitation, department of human services, as an ex
16	officio, voting member;

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1	[(2)]	(3) The private sector chairpersons of the four
2		county workforce development boards, or their
3		designees from the private sector membership of their
4		respective boards, as ex officio, voting members;
5	[-(3)]	(4) Seventeen representatives from the private
6		sector, including nonprofit organizations and
7		businesses in the State, appointed from individuals
8		nominated by state business organizations and business
9		trade associations;
10	[-(4)]	(5) Eight representatives from labor organizations
11		and workforce training organizations, two or more of
12		whom shall be representatives of labor organizations
13		who have been nominated by state labor federations,
14		and one of whom shall be a labor representative from a
15		community-based native Hawaiian organization that
16		operates workforce development programs;
17	[(5)]	(6) A member of each house of the legislature, for
18		two-year terms beginning in January of odd-numbered
19		years, appointed by the appropriate presiding officer
20		of each house, as ex officio, voting members;

1	$[\frac{(6)}{(7)}]$ The four mayors or their designees, as ex
2	officio, voting members; and
3	$[\frac{(7)}{(8)}]$ The governor or the governor's designee."
4	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
