
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The elections commission shall, in
2 consultation with the clerk of each county, perform an
3 assessment of whether the election watcher and election observer
4 programs are adequate and, if not, what adjustments are
5 necessary to improve the programs.

6 (b) The elections commission shall submit a report of its
7 assessment, including recommendations and proposed legislation,
8 to the legislature no later than forty days prior to the
9 convening of the regular session of 2022.

10 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
