A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOUSING OBJECTIVES.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 226-19, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows:

3 "\$226-19 Objectives and policies for socio-cultural

4 advancement -- housing. (a) Planning for the State's socio-

cultural advancement with regard to housing shall be directed

toward the achievement of the following objectives:

(1) Greater opportunities for Hawaii's people to secure reasonably priced, safe, sanitary, and livable homes, located in suitable environments that satisfactorily accommodate the needs and desires of families and individuals, through collaboration and cooperation between government and nonprofit and for-profit developers to ensure that more rental and for sale affordable housing is made available to extremely low-, very low-, lower-, moderate-, and above

moderate-income segments of Hawaii's population[-];

16	(3)	Increase homeownership and rental opportunities and
