Section 226-19, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 3 "(b) To achieve the housing objectives [- it shall be the 4 policy of [this] the State [to:], the Hawaii housing finance 5 and development corporation and the Hawaii public housing 6 authority shall: 7 (1) Effectively accommodate the housing needs of Hawaii's 8 people. 9 (2) Stimulate and promote feasible approaches that increase affordable rental and for sale housing 10 11 choices for extremely low-, very low-, lower-, 12 moderate-, and above moderate-income households. (3) 13 Increase homeownership and rental opportunities and 14 choices in terms of quality, location, cost,

densities, style, and size of housing.
