BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

3	(7)	Ensure that state facilities are managed in accordance
4		with proper repair, maintenance, and sanitation,
5		including the establishment and communication of
6		sanitation procedures for the health and safety of

8	[-(7)]	(8) Undertake the functions of the state surveyor;
9	[(8)]	(9) Establish accounting and internal control
10		systems;
11	[(9)]	(10) Under the direction of the chief information
12		officer, provide centralized computer information
13		management and processing services;

15		public access to public information and develop an
