BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 368D-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) No person in the State, on the basis of sex,
- 4 including gender identity or expression as defined in section
- 5 489-2, [or] sexual orientation as defined in section 489-2, or
- 6 disability as defined in section 368-1.5, shall be excluded from
- 7 participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to
- 8 discrimination under:
- 9 (1) Any state educational program or activity; or
- 10 (2) Any educational program or activity that receives
- state financial assistance."
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 13 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 14 begun before its effective date.
- 15 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
