The sums appropriated for the respective 3 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be 4 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows: 5 6 The sums appropriated in items 1 through 6 shall be (1)7 expended by the department of education; and 8 (2) The sums appropriated in item 7 shall be expended by 9 the department of land and natural resources. SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021. 10 11
