## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ILLEGAL GAMBLING.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 712-1221, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by	y amending subsection (1) to read as follows:
3	"(1)	A person commits the offense of promoting gambling in
4	the first	degree if the person knowingly advances or profits
5	from gambl	ling activity by:
6	(a)	Engaging in bookmaking to the extent that the person
7		receives or accepts in any seven-day period more than
8		five bets totaling more than \$500;
9	(d)	Receiving in connection with a lottery, or mutuel
10		scheme or enterprise, money or written records from a
11		person other than a player whose chances or plays are
12		represented by such money or records; [or]
13	(c)	Receiving or having become due and payable in
14		connection with a lottery, mutuel, or other gambling
15		scheme or enterprise, more than \$1,000 in any
16		seven-day period played in the scheme or
17		enterprise[-]; or

1	(d) Engaging in activities in which a person receives or
2	entertains other persons as guests with the intent of
3	advancing gambling activity on real property."
4	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
5	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
6	begun before its effective date.
7	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
8	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
9	SECTION 4 This Act shall take effect on January 1 2050
