A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FOOD SUSTAINABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. (a) Pursuant to section 226-55, Hawaii Revised		
2	Statutes, the department of agriculture, in coordination with		
3	the office of planning, shall prepare and periodically update		
4	the agricultural functional plan to include other agricultural		
5	economic updates, seafood sustainability that expands the		
6	State's priority on food by including wild seafood as a viable		
7	food source.		
8	(b) As part of the updated agricultural functional plan,		
9	which shall include among other agricultural economic updates,		
10	seafood sustainability, the department of agriculture and the		
11	office of planning shall consider the following:		
12	(1) Establishing objectives, policies, and actions related		
13	to seafood sustainability;		
14	(2) Researching the agricultural and economic impact that		
15	wild seafood has on food self-sufficiency in the		
16	State, including its influence on non-commercial		

1		consumption, such as community sharing and fisher	
2		household consumption, and exports;	
3	(3)	Collecting data on the wholesale and retail sales of	
4		wild seafood in the State;	
5	(4)	Classifying and regulating wild seafood as a food	
6		commodity in the State; and	
7	(5)	Incorporating the seafood sustainability into the	
8		state agricultural functional plan related to	
9		increased food security and food self-sufficiency.	
10	(c)	The governor shall submit the functional plan pursuant	
11	to section	n 226-56, Hawaii Revised Statutes, including any	
12	proposed :	legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty	
13	days prio	r to the convening of the regular session of 2023.	
14	(d)	For the purposes of this section, "wild seafood" means	
15	naturally	-born or hatchery-raised fish and shellfish harvested	
16	in the wi	ld through commercial, recreational, or subsistence	
17	fishing, but excluding net-pen aquacultural or other farm-raise		
18	fish.		
19	SECT	ION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Requires the department of agriculture, in coordination with the office of planning, to prepare and periodically update the state agricultural functional plan for seafood sustainability that expands the State's priority on food by including wild seafood as a viable food source. (SD1)

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
