A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2	general obligation bonds in the sum of \$191,752,000 or so much
3	thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4	as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2021-2022
5	for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the third
6	senatorial district, as follows:
7	1. Ke Kula o Ehunuikaimalino
8	A. Plans, design, and construction
9	for new portables or permanent
10	classrooms, inclusive of master
11	plan, and ultimate site plan for
12	school campus relocation; ground
13	and site improvements; equipment

2	improveme	nt projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
3	the end o	f the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
4	made; pro	vided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
5	unencumbe	red as of June 30, 2024, shall lapse as of that date.
6	SECT	ION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
7	capital i	mprovement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
8	expended	for the purposes of this Act as follows:
9	(1)	The sums appropriated in items (1), (4), (5), (6),
10		(8), (9), (10), (11), (12), and (13) shall be expended
11		by the department of education;
12	(2)	The sums appropriated in item (2) and (13) shall be
13		expended by the department of Hawaiian home lands;
14	(3)	The sums appropriated in item (3) and (17) shall be
15		expended by the Hawaii health systems corporation;
16	(4)	The sum appropriated in items (7) shall be expended by
17		the department of health;
18	(5)	The sums appropriated in items (14) and (15) shall be
19		expended by the department of land and natural
20		resources; and

(6) The sum appropriated in item (16) shall be expended by
the department of transportation.
