A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
general obligation bonds in the sum of \$191,752,000 or so much
thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2021-2022
for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the third
senatorial district, as follows:

1. Ke Kula o Ehunuikaimalino

A. Plans, design, and construction
for new portables or permanent
classrooms, inclusive of master
plan, and ultimate site plan for
school campus relocation; ground
and site improvements; equipment
and appurtenances.

1 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
2 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
3 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
4 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
5 unencumbered as of June 30, 2024, shall lapse as of that date.

6 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
7 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
8 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:

9 (1) The sums appropriated in items (1), (4), (5), (6),
10 (8), (9), (10), (11), (12), and (13) shall be expended
11 by the department of education;

12 (2) The sums appropriated in item (2) and (13) shall be
13 expended by the department of Hawaiian home lands;

14 (3) The sums appropriated in item (3) and (17) shall be
15 expended by the Hawaii health systems corporation;

16 (4) The sum appropriated in items (7) shall be expended by
17 the department of health;

18 (5) The sums appropriated in items (14) and (15) shall be
19 expended by the department of land and natural
20 resources; and

1 (6) The sum appropriated in item (16) shall be expended by
2 the department of transportation.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
