## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE BUILDING CODE COUNCIL.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 82, Session Laws
- 2 of Hawaii 2007, codified in part II of chapter 107, Hawaii
- 3 Revised Statutes, established the state building code council to
- 4 adopt a uniform set of statewide building codes applicable to
- 5 one- and two-family dwellings and all other residential,
- 6 commercial, industrial, and state buildings to facilitate the
- 7 application of consistent standards by building owners,
- 8 designers, contractors, and code enforcers within the State.
- 9 The legislature recognizes that the jurisdiction of the
- 10 department of accounting and general services is limited to that
- 11 of state buildings. Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to
- 12 administratively relocate the state building code council from
- 13 the department of accounting and general services to the Hawaii
- 14 state energy office.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 107-21, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended by amending the definition of "department".

20	assistant	, and other staff, shall be included in the budget of
