A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE HOLIDAYS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Juneteenth, also 2 known as Freedom Day or Juneteenth Independence Day, is an 3 American holiday that commemorates the June 19, 1865, 4 announcement of the abolition of slavery in Texas, and more 5 generally, the emancipation of enslaved African Americans 6 throughout the former Confederate states. At the beginning of 7 2020, Hawaii was one of only three states that had not 8 recognized Juneteenth as a state holiday or special day of 9 observance. Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to 10 establish June 19 of each year as a state holiday to be known as 11 Juneteenth Day. 12 SECTION 2. Section 8-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 13 amended to read as follows:

14 "\$8-1 Holidays designated. The following days of each
15 year are set apart and established as state holidays:
16 The first day in January, New Year's Day;
