RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 11-338, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) The candidate, authorized person in the case of a 4 noncandidate committee that is a party, or treasurer in the case 5 of a candidate committee or other noncandidate committee, that, 6 within the period of fourteen calendar days through four 7 calendar days [prior to] before any election $[\tau]$ for which the 8 candidate is on the ballot, makes contributions aggregating more 9 than \$500, or receives contributions from any person aggregating more than \$500, shall file a late contribution report by means 10 11 of the commission's electronic filing system on or before the 12 third calendar day [prior to] before the election for which the 13 candidate is on the ballot."

14 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
