#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to increase the
- 2 accountability of state and county employers with respect to
- 3 payment of wages to their employees in a timely manner.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 388-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 5 amended by amending the definition of "employer" to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 ""Employer" includes any individual, partnership,
- 8 association, joint-stock company, trust, corporation, the
- 9 personal representative of the estate of a deceased individual
- 10 or the receiver, trustee, or successor of any of the same,
- 11 employing any person, but shall not include [the State or any
- 12 political subdivision thereof or the United States [+]; provided
- 13 that the term includes the State and any political subdivision
- 14 thereof only when a provision of this chapter has no comparable
- 15 provision in chapter 78."
