A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MEDICAL CANNABIS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that restricting the
- 2 interisland transportation of cannabis by patients for their
- 3 personal medical use is contrary to the intent of Hawai'i laws
- 4 that authorize qualifying patients to use medical cannabis.
- 5 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to protect the
- 6 rights of qualifying patients to use medical cannabis by
- 7 specifically authorizing the interisland transportation of
- 8 cannabis for personal medical use.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 329-122, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 amended by amending subsection (f) to read as follows:
- "(f) For the purposes of this section, "transport" means
- 12 the transportation of cannabis, usable cannabis, or any
- 13 manufactured cannabis product between:
- 14 (1) A qualifying patient and the qualifying patient's
- primary caregiver;

1	(2)	A qualifying out-of-state patient under eighteen years	
2		of age and the caregiver of a qualifying out-of-state	
3		patient;	
4	(3)	The production centers and the retail dispensing	
5		locations under a dispensary licensee's license; or	
6	(4)	A production center, retail dispensing location,	
7		qualifying patient, primary caregiver, qualifying out-	
8		of-state patient, or caregiver of a qualifying out-of-	
9		state patient and a certified laboratory for the	
10		purpose of laboratory testing; provided that a	
11		qualifying patient, primary caregiver, qualifying out-	
12		of-state patient, or caregiver of a qualifying out-of-	
13		state patient may only transport up to one gram of	
14		cannabis per test to a certified laboratory for	
15		laboratory testing and may only transport the product	
16		if the qualifying patient, primary caregiver,	
17		qualifying out-of-state patient, or caregiver of a	
18		qualifying out-of-state patient:	
19		(A) Secures an appointment for testing at a certified	
20		laboratory;	

1	(B)	Obtains confirmation, which may be electronic,		
2		that includes the specific time and date of the		
3		appointment and a detailed description of the		
4		product and amount to be transported to the		
5		certified laboratory for the appointment; and		
6	(C)	Has the confirmation, which may be electronic,		
7		available during transport.		
8	For purposes of interisland transportation, "transport" of			
9	cannabis, usab	le cannabis, or any manufactured cannabis product,		
10	by any means is allowable only by a qualifying patient or			
11	qualifying out-of-state patient for the patient's personal			
12	medical use, or between a production center or retail dispensin			
13	location and a certified laboratory for the sole purpose of			
14	laboratory testing pursuant to section 329D-8, as permitted			
15	under section $329D-6(m)$ and subject to section $329D-6(j)$, and			
16	with the understanding that state law and its protections do no			
17	apply outside of the jurisdictional limits of the State.			
18	Allowable transport pursuant to this section does not include			
19	interisland transportation by any means or for any purpose			
20	between a qualified patient, primary caregiver, qualifying out-			
21	of-state patient, or caregiver of a qualifying out-of-state			

- 1 patient and any other entity or individual, including an
- 2 individual who is a qualified patient, primary caregiver,
- 3 qualifying out-of-state patient, or caregiver of a qualifying
- 4 out-of-state patient."
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 6 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 7 begun before its effective date.
- 8 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on May 6, 2137.
