A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMERCIAL MARINE LICENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that fishing is an

2 important pastime for many Hawaii residents, providing not only

3 recreational and subsistence benefits, but also an additional

4 source of income for many small-scale commercial fishers who

5 often sell a portion of their catch to cover costs of fuel or

6 fishing gear.

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7 The legislature further finds that the current commercial

8 marine license laws are unnecessarily burdensome on boat-based

fishers due to the requirement that each individual on a fishing

vessel must have a commercial marine license to participate in a

11 commercial fishing trip where the resulting catch may be sold.

12 This places logistical and financial burdens on vessel captains

when part-time crew members are needed for a commercial fishing

14 trip or when unscheduled or infrequent visitors are invited

15 aboard. It also leads to confusion about who is responsible for

16 submitting commercial catch reports for fishing activities

17 aboard a vessel.

3	commercia	al marine license, it is unclear whether shore-based
4	charters	are also required to obtain a commercial marine
5	license.	
6	The	purpose of this Act is to:
7	(1)	Authorize the department of land and natural resources
8		to establish requirements and fees for obtaining a
9		commercial marine vessel license;
10	(2)	Specify that a single commercial marine vessel license
11		satisfies the licensure requirement for all persons
12		aboard the licensed vessel;
13	(3)	Require any person providing fishing charter services
14		to obtain a commercial marine license; and
15	(4)	Allow marine charter fishing vessels to obtain
16		commercial marine vessel licenses.
17	SECT	CION 2. Section 189-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
18	amended to read as follows:	
19	" §18	9-2 Commercial marine license. (a) No person shall

take marine life for commercial purposes whether the marine life

is caught or taken within or outside of the State, without first

- 2 section[-]; provided that a single valid commercial marine
- 3 vessel license shall satisfy the licensure requirement for all
- 4 persons taking marine life for commercial purposes aboard the
- 5 validly-licensed vessel.
- 6 (b) [Additionally, any] Any person providing [vessel]
- 7 charter services in the State for the taking of marine life in
- 8 or outside of the State shall obtain a commercial marine
- 9 license.
- 10 (c) Any vessel used for or engaged in the taking of marine
- 11 life for commercial purposes may obtain a commercial marine
- 12 <u>ves</u>sel license.
- 13 $\left[\frac{(c)}{(c)}\right]$ (d) The department may adopt rules pursuant to
- 14 chapter 91 necessary for the purpose of this section and to set
- 15 fees for commercial marine [licensing.] and commercial marine
- 16 vessel licenses.
- 17 $\left[\frac{d}{d}\right]$ (e) The fees for commercial marine and commercial
- 18 marine vessel licenses and duplicate commercial marine and
- 19 commercial marine vessel licenses shall be established by the
- 20 department by rules adopted in accordance with chapter 91.

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1 [(e)] (f) The department shall suspend, shall refuse to 2 renew, reinstate, or restore, or shall deny any license issued 3 under this section if the department has received certification 4 from the child support enforcement agency pursuant to section 5 576D-13 that the licensee or applicant is not in compliance with 6 an order of support or has failed to comply with a subpoena or 7 warrant relating to a paternity or child support proceeding. 8 The department shall issue, renew, reinstate, or restore an 9 affected license only upon receipt of authorization from the 10 child support enforcement agency, the office of child support 11 hearings, or the family court." 12 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed

and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

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SECTION 4.

Report Title:

Commercial Marine Licenses; Commercial Marine Vessel Licenses; Charter Services

Description:

Authorizes the department of land and natural resources to establish rules and fees for the issuance of a commercial marine vessel license. Provides that a single valid commercial marine vessel license satisfies the licensure requirement for all persons aboard the licensed vessel. Requires any person who provides fishing charter services to obtain a commercial marine license. Allows marine charter fishing vessels to obtain commercial marine vessel licenses. (SD1)

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
