A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREARMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that existing law allows 2 firearms to be lent to an adult for up to seventy-five days 3 without any background check or notice to the government that a firearm has been lent to a person who does not have a permit for 4 5 that weapon. The legislature further finds that this is not 6 consistent with the rest of the firearm regulations, which requires background checks and permitting for all gun 7 8 transferees. 9 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to: 10 (1) Restrict the loan of a rifle or shotgun to an adult 11 who is twenty-one years or older; 12 Repeal the authorization to lend a rifle or shotgun (2) 13 without a permit;

(3) Restrict the lending of a rifle or shotgun to twelve

Report Title:

Firearms; Lending; Firearm Permit; Firearm Registration

Description:

Prohibits a person from lending a firearm to a person who does not have a firearm permit or does not have a registered firearm. Requires an adult who is borrowing a firearm to have either a firearm permit or a registered firearm, and not be prohibited to own or possess a firearm. Specifies that an adult who is twenty-one years of age or older may be lent a rifle or shotgun for a period not to exceed twelve hours. Repeals the authorization to use a rifle or shotgun outside of the State for up to seventy-five days. Repeals the authorization to lend a rifle or shotgun without a permit.
