### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO REGISTRATION FEES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 249-31.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
  2 amended to read as follows:
  3 "§249-31.5 Exemptions from registration fees for certain
- 4 vehicles; reduced registration fees; disabled veterans. (a) A
- 5 disabled veteran who:
- 6 (1) Is a resident of Hawaii;
- 7 (2) Has been other than dishonorably discharged from the
  8 United States uniformed armed forces; and
- 9 (3) Is determined by the United States Department of
  10 Veterans Affairs or its predecessor to have a service11 connected one hundred per cent disability rating for
  12 compensation or a service-connected disability rating
  13 of one hundred per cent,
- 14 shall be exempt from payment of all annual vehicle registration
- 15 fees as required by section 249-31; provided that this exemption
- 16 shall not extend to any vehicle used for commercial purposes or
- 17 to more than one vehicle owned by the disabled veteran.

- 5 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that

- 10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
