A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TORT LIABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the liability
- 2 protections afforded to lifequards in Act 170, Session Laws of
- 3 Hawaii 2002, were repealed on June 30, 2017. Act 170 provided
- 4 liability protection for lifeguard services on the beach or in
- 5 the ocean, except for gross negligence or wanton acts or
- 6 omissions. This limited liability protection was made necessary
- 7 because some counties would not provide lifeguard services at
- 8 state beach parks, due to the fear of potential liability that
- 9 might ensue. The legislature finds that Act 170 created a
- 10 climate in which lifequard services could be provided by the
- 11 counties without fear of liability and, therefore, is a life
- 12 saving measure that should be reestablished.
- Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to permanently
- 14 reinstate the liability protections previously afforded for
- 15 lifequard services.

- 1 SECTION 2. Chapter 663, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§663- Exception to liability for county lifeguard
- 5 **services.** (a) For the purposes of this section:
- 6 "County lifeguard" means a person employed as a lifeguard
- 7 by a county of this State.
- 8 "Employing county" means the county employing a county
- 9 lifeguard.
- 10 (b) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, neither
- 11 a county lifeguard, the employing county, nor the State shall be
- 12 liable for any civil damages resulting from any act or omission
- 13 of the lifeguard while providing rescue, resuscitative, or other
- 14 lifeguard services on the beach or in the ocean in the scope of
- 15 employment as a county lifeguard; provided that this exception
- 16 from liability shall not apply when the claim for civil damages
- 17 arises from a county lifeguard's alleged gross negligence or
- 18 wanton act or omission."
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 20 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 21 begun before its effective date.
