## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN SPENDING COMMISSION STAFF.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-311, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 3 "(b) The commission shall consist of five members 4 representing the general public and who are appointed by the governor from a list of ten nominees submitted by the judicial 5 6 council. A vacancy on the commission shall be filled from the 7 list of nominees or by the reappointment of a commissioner whose 8 term has expired, subject to the limit on length of service imposed by section 26-34. The judicial council shall meet and 9 10 expeditiously select additional persons for the list of nominees 11 whenever the number of the eligible nominees falls below five. 12 Notwithstanding section 26-34, appointments to the commission 13 shall not be subject to the advice and consent of the senate. 14 The commission may employ staff who may initiate complaints 15 under section 11-402; provided that the staff shall not be 16 members of the commission."
