BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 11-158, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
3	"(c) All mandatory recounts of votes under this section
4	shall be completed and the results publicly announced no later
5	than [seventy-two hours after the closing of polls on election
6	day.] five business days after the date of the election."
7	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
8	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
9	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
