RELATING TO FELONIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 711-1112, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+] §711-1112[+] Interference with the operator or
- 4 operation of a public transit vehicle. (1) A person commits
- 5 the offense of interference with the operator of a public
- 6 transit vehicle if the person interferes with the operation of a
- 7 public transit vehicle or lessens the ability of the operator to
- 8 operate the public transit vehicle by:
- 9 (a) Intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly causing bodily
- injury to the operator of the public transit vehicle;
- 11 [or]
- 12 (b) Threatening, by word or conduct, to cause bodily
- injury to the operator of the public transit vehicle
- 14 with the intent to terrorize, or in reckless disregard
- of the risk of terrorizing the operator of the public
- 16 transit vehicle [-]; or

1	(c) Intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly causing the
2	delay, malfunction, or breakdown of an automated
3	operation of a public transit vehicle, system, or
4	service.
5	(2) For the purposes of this section, "public transit
6	vehicle" is a public paratransit vehicle providing service to
7	the disabled, any transit vehicle used for the transportation of
8	passengers in return for legally charged fees or fares, any
9	transit vehicle owned or operated by a government entity, any
10	school bus, or any taxi.
11	(3) Interference with the operator or operation of a
12	public transit vehicle is a class C felony."
13	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
14	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
15	begun before its effective date.
16	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
18	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
