A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MARIJUANA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 712-1245, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:
3	"(1) A person commits the offense of promoting a harmful
4	drug in the second degree if the person knowingly:
5	(a) Possesses fifty or more capsules or tablets or dosage
6	units containing one or more of the harmful drugs or
7	one or more of the marijuana concentrates, or any
8	combination thereof;
9	(b) Possesses [one]:
10	(i) One or more preparations, compounds, mixtures, or
11	substances, of an aggregate weight of one-eighth
12	ounce or more, containing one or more of the
13	harmful drugs [or one or more of the marijuana
14	<pre>concentrates, or any combination thereof];</pre>
15	(ii) One or more preparations, compounds, mixtures, or
16	substances, of an aggregate weight of one-eighth
17	ounce or more, containing one or more of the

1	marijuana concentrates if the person is outside
2	of the person's primary residence, or an
3	aggregate weight of one ounce or more, containing
4	one or more of the marijuana concentrates if the
5	person is inside of the person's primary
6	residence; or
7	(c) Distributes any harmful drug [or any marijuana
8	concentrate] in any amount[.] or over five grams of
9	any marijuana concentrate."
10	SECTION 2. Section 712-1248, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
11	amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:
12	"(1) A person commits the offense of promoting a
13	detrimental drug in the second degree if the person knowingly:
14	(a) Possesses fifty or more capsules or tablets containing
15	one or more of the Schedule V substances;
16	(b) Possesses one or more preparations, compounds,
17	mixtures, or substances, of an aggregate weight of
18	one- eighth ounce or more, containing one or more of
19	the Schedule V substances;

1	(c)	Possesses one or more préparations, compounds,	
2		mixtures, or substances, of an aggregate weight of one	
3		ounce or more[, containing any marijuana]; [or]	
4	(d)	Distributes [any marijuana or] any Schedule V	
5		substance in any amount[→]; or	
6	<u>(e)</u>	Distributes any marijuana to an individual younger	
7		than twenty-one years of age."	
8	SECT	ION 3. Section 712-1249, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
9	amended t	o read as follows:	
10	"§71	2-1249 Promoting a detrimental drug in the third	
11	degree.	(1) A person commits the offense of promoting a	
12	detrimental drug in the third degree if the person knowingly		
13	possesses	[any] <u>:</u>	
14	<u>(a)</u>	Ten ounces or more of marijuana if the person is	
15		inside the person's primary residence or one ounce or	
16		more of marijuana if the person is outside the	
17		person's primary residence; or [any]	
18	<u>(b)</u>	Any Schedule V substance in any amount.	
19	(2)	Promoting a detrimental drug in the third degree is a

Report Title:

Marijuana; Decriminalization

Description:

Decriminalizes without penalty possession of up to one ounce of marijuana or one-eighth ounce of marijuana concentrate outside of a personal residence and up to ten ounces of marijuana or one ounce of marijuana concentrate inside a personal residence. Removes the penalty for transferring up to one ounce of marijuana or five grams of marijuana concentrate to individuals twenty-one years of age or older.
