### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRONIC TRANSMISSION OF BALLOTS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-107, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+] §11-107[+] Electronic transmission under certain
- 4 circumstances. (a) If a ballot package is not received by a
- 5 voter by the fifth day before the date of the election or a
- 6 voter otherwise requires a replacement ballot within five days
- 7 of an election, the voter may request that a ballot be forwarded
- 8 by electronic transmission[<del>, provided that a voter with special</del>
- 9 needs may request that a ballot be forwarded by electronic
- 10 transmission at any time]. Upon receipt of such a request and
- 11 confirmation that proper application was made, the clerk may
- 12 transmit the appropriate ballot, together with a form containing
- 13 the affirmations, information, and a waiver of the right to
- 14 secrecy under section 11-137.
- (b) The voter may return the completed replacement ballot
- 16 and executed forms:

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1	(1)	By electronic transmission so that the completed
2		replacement ballot and executed forms are received at
3		the office of the clerk no later than the closing time
4		provided in section 11-131 on the date of the
5		election;

- (2) By mail so that the completed replacement ballot and executed forms are received at the office of the clerk no later than the closing time provided in section 11-131 on the date of the election;
- (3) By personal delivery to any place of deposit no later than 7:00 p.m. on the date of the election; provided that any voter who is standing in line at a place of deposit at 7:00 p.m. on the date of the election with the intent of returning a ballot and casting a vote shall be allowed to vote; or
- (4) By personal delivery to a voter service center no later than the closing time provided in section 11-131 on the date of the election; provided that any voter who is standing in line at a voter service center at the closing time provided in section 11-131 on the

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1	date of the election with the intent of returning a
2	ballot and casting a vote shall be allowed to vote.
3	(c) A voter with special needs may request that a ballot
4	be forwarded by electronic transmission at any time. Upon
5	receipt of such a request and confirmation that proper
6	application was made, the clerk may transmit the appropriate
7	ballot, together with a form containing the affirmations,
8	information, and a means of electronic authentication that does
9	not include the voter's handwritten signature or a waiver of
10	secrecy. The voter with special needs may return the completed
11	ballot and executed forms by any of the methods specified in
12	subsection (b); provided that the voter's handwritten signature
13	or a waiver of secrecy shall not be required.
14	$[\frac{(c)}{(c)}]$ (d) Upon receipt, the clerk shall verify compliance
15	with the requirements of this part; provided that if the voter
16	returns multiple voted ballots for the same election, the clerk
17	shall prepare only the first ballot returned that is not
18	spoiled."
19	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
20	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

## S.B. NO. 534

### Report Title:

Deaf and Blind Task Force; Electronic Transmission of Ballots; Electronic Authentication

### Description:

Provides that a voter with special needs shall be provided a means of electronic authentication of an electronic transmission of replacement ballot that does not include the voter's handwritten signature or a waiver of secrecy.

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
